

## **Inspiration Social Committee June 13, 2019 Meeting Minutes**

Minutes:

- Mark Kinslow opened memo discussion
  - Jeff Brown presented proposal regarding social budget and proposed solution to stop all social events
  - Kaylyn provided statistics regarding email distribution to community. 1,118 emails are registered out of 770 homes that are closed. Average of 70% opened with 8,000 click throughs.
  - Provided additional ideas for including campaigns in the emails to highlight what is important.
  - Proposal to invite city representatives to Independence Day celebration and round table discussion
  - Committee members were in agreement that this was not the desired solution
  - Lindsey Linkow invited Jeff to present his concerns regarding budget at the board meetings.
  
- Kari Munson opened update on Summer Programming
  - Volunteer info packet is continuing to evolve
  - Desire to keep volunteers limited to committee members
  - Promotion of events encouraged to be posted in FB

- Mark Kinslow update that 1 person attended the bike ride event
  - Update on items put in place since last meeting. Providing “how to get connected” cards and calendar of events being posted at the pool
  - Discussion by committee about the potential to post information at mailbox locations across community.
  - Proposal to create a monument sign that would allow for permanent and effective communication across the community for upcoming events.
- Independence Day celebration
    - This would need to be a committee run event.
    - Margo Walters updated that previous “uncle Sam” was not available for the event
    - Decision to keep it simple with parade for kids with adult at beginning and end and decision to not do prizes, simple give aways, and popsicles at the pool
    - Check with neighbors in community for potential sound system.
    - Kari to check with fire department to see if possible
- Kari Munson, CCMC, provided update on ideas for Farm to Inspiration
    - Ideas for an artisan approach to the events. To include food trucks and vendors with local tastings and potential for art/activity.
    - More to be discovered and finalized
    - Sponsorship opportunity for this event. Kari will create a google doc for gathering sponsors.
    - Potential vendors including Sweet Williams Market, Penzy Spice People, additional vendors in our neighborhood
- Kari Munson began discussion about Pooch Plunge and planning
    - Mark K brought up idea that there is a draining and refilling of the pool that may need to take place.
    - Kaylin assured all that all rules and guidelines would be followed
    - Ideas for sponsors and fun vendors proposed for event
      - Potential for Parker brewery that is dog themed.
