

## Inspiration Common Area Committee March 6, 2018 Meeting Minutes

- Meeting called to order at 6:09
- Members in attendance:
  - Aaron Curtiss
  - Graham Lammers
  - Ron Lee

- Agenda posted online and in accordance with notice rules approved unanimously
- Kayla Nelson from Newland continued the discussion with board and community members about the park planning process for the amenity east of Gartrell Road
  - Following up on her prior presentation, she said she was planning to meet with City of Aurora staff to go over what options were available
  - The committee provided feedback based on the prior meeting and presentation
    - Unanimous agreement that it should be a more natural park
    - Unanimous agreement on the types of amenities proposed
    - A desire was expressed for a teen- or tween-oriented amenity
      - Kayla said it may be added to Pathfinder Park instead and could include:
        - Zip line
        - Skate rail
        - Volleyball
    - A desire was expressed for some sort of garden feature
      - Kayla said garden features are very hard to maintain and keep looking nice because they are less popular in master-planned communities
    - Accessibility was discussed
      - Does the road need to be paved?
    - Maintenance needs of the proposed dog park were discussed
- Graham Lammers and Aaron Curtiss updated the committee on the status of the Aurora Beautification Grant
- Hannah Toole led the discussion about Earth Day event planning
  - The committee agreed to help put on a low-cost event that engaged the community as well as the builders and Newland
  - The theme would trash pickup, tree planting and activities for kids
