

**Inspiration Common Area Committee

- During public comment:
  - The shrubs at Rockinghorse Parkway and Gartrell obstructed the view; Ron Lee and Greg Wolgamott said they would investigate and report back
  - The drainage at the open space near Catawba is constantly clogged with construction debris; Kaylin Hicks of CCMC said Newland will investigate
  - The lighting at the Inspiration sign still throws off a lot of glare; Hicks said she would discuss with Kayla Nelson at Newland
- Hicks updated the committee on landscape projects for 2018
  - The second mow of native grasses was pushed back to August
  - Additional flowers were added to the median along Rockinghorse Parkway at no charge by Brightview
  - The tree replacement plan is underway
  - The turf mite spray is showing positive results
  - The budgeting process for 2019 will begin in late summer, with landscape projects factored in
  - The turf in Pathfinder Park is undergoing remediation for thistles
  - Perennials instead of annuals will be investigated for the marquee planting areas at the community gateways
- The committee began discussion of an event to install the Little Free Library
  - Brightview will donate the auger for the post holes
  - Tallyn's Reach library will provide a table and storytime
  - Hannah Toole will help coordinate event, but will not be onsite the day of
