

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-06-01**

**RESOLUTION  
OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF  
INSPIRATION METROPOLITAN DISTRICT**

**DECLARING OPENING ALL OF THE PUBLIC AMENITIES**

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WHEREAS, Inspiration Metropolitan District (the “**District**”) is a quasi-municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Colorado (the “**State**”) organized to serve a public use and promote the health, safety, prosperity, security and general welfare of the residents of the District and the State; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 32-1-1001(1)(h), C.R.S., the Board of Directors of the District (the “**Board**”) is empowered with the management, control, and supervision of all the business and affairs of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State (the “**Governor**”) verbally declared a state of emergency on March 10, 2020 and issued Executive Order D 2020 003 on March 11, 2020, which has subsequently been extended, (the “**Emergency**”) due to the threat that COVID-19 coronavirus (“**COVID-19**”) poses to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the State; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, the Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment (the “**CDPHE**”) issued Public Health Order 20-23 (the “**Order**”) limiting all mass gatherings to no more than ten (10) people; and

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2020, in an effort to comply with the Order and to protect the health and safety of the residents of the District, the Board adopted Resolution No. 2020-04-04, which closed the District’s tennis courts, roller skate/basketball area, play structure at Pathfinder park, pool and associated play area and the Hops Garden, and suspended District-sponsored social and community events; and

WHEREAS, on April 26, 2020, the CDPHE issued Public Health Order 20-28 implementing “Safer at Home” guidelines (the “**Guidelines**”), which limited public gatherings outside a residence to no more than ten (10) people, except for the purposes expressly permitted therein, and to the extent possible encouraged compliance with Social Distancing Requirements (as defined in the Guidelines); and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2020, the Governor issued Executive Order D 2020 091, known as Safer at Home and in the Vast Great Outdoors, which will be in effect until July 1, 2020, unless extended, which allows, in part, for certain recreational activities involving more than ten (10) people; and

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2020, CDPHE issued Public Health Order 20-28 (the “**Amended Order**”) authorizing the opening of playgrounds, outdoor sports facilities, outdoor swimming pools, gyms, recreation centers and indoor pools on June 4, 2020, under certain capacity restrictions; and

WHEREAS, the Amended Order provides that playgrounds may open for use by no more than twenty-five (25) people at a time; and

WHEREAS, the Amended Order provides that outdoor sports facilities for individual (non-league) use may be open to up to twenty-five (25) people at a time per court or per field; and;

WHEREAS, the Amended Order provides that outdoor pools may open at fifty percent (50%) capacity or fifty (50) people, whichever is less; and

WHEREAS, the Amended Order provides that gyms and recreation centers may open with no more than twenty-five percent (25%) capacity or fifty (50) people, whoever is fewer, per room, so long as people can stay six (6) feet apart from each other; and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2020, the CDPHE issued guidance for the opening of outdoor and indoor pools, gyms and recreation centers (the “**Personal Recreation Guidance**”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to, and in compliance with, the Amended Order and the Personal Recreation Guidance, the Board has determined to reopen the District’s tennis courts, roller skate/basketball area, play structure at Pathfinder park, pool and associated play area and Hops Garden effective June 9, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the suspension of District-sponsored social and community events set forth in Resolution No. 2020-04-04 shall remain in place.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

1. Opening of Public Amenities. The Board hereby declares that effective June 9, 2020, tennis courts, roller skate/basketball area, play structure at Pathfinder park, pool and associated play area and Hops Garden will re-open to any and all access that existed prior to the Emergency.

2. Operational Procedures. The Board hereby adopts the operational policies and procedures attached hereto at **Exhibit A** for the pool, as may be amended from time to time by the Board due to changes in circumstances, new or amended Orders issued by the Governor and/or new or amended Public Health Orders and Guidance issued by the CDPHE.

3. District Events. The suspension of District-sponsored social and community events set forth in Resolution 2020-04-04 remains in effect until the Board determines that the emergency conditions necessitating the suspension no longer exist.

4. Termination. This Resolution shall remain in effect until such time that the Emergency no longer exists, as determined by the State, and/or repealed by the Board.


