

Inspiration Common Area Committee November 21, 2017 Meeting Minutes

- Meeting called to order at 6:05p
- Members in attendance:

- Agenda posted online and in accordance with notice rules approved unanimously
- Minutes from meeting of October 17, 2017 approved unanimously
- Kayla Nelson from Newland presented two 2018 programs for involvement of the committee and larger community
 - Inspiration Neighborhood Park will be a 4.5-acre amenity on the east side of Gartrell Road
 - City of Aurora requires the park to include:
 - Play structure
 - Shade shelter
 - Picnic facility
 - Multi-purpose lawn
 - Parking
 - The conceptualization process will involve the committee and the community to determine other aspects
 - Entitlement is expected to begin in 2018
 - Buildout is expected to take approximately one year, with completion in 2019
 - Inspiration Public Art utilizes the public art funding from the mill levy to install professional art throughout the community
 - First piece was the bird mural on Gartrell
 - Anticipate the first call for entries in Spring of 2018, with the next piece as early as Summer of 2018
 - Art must be:
 - Dispersed evenly throughout the community
 - Original
 - Professionally produced
 - Durable – i.e., sculptures, mosaics, murals – not landscaping

- The committee discussed the framework for the Adopt-A-Planter program and agreed to postpone further discussion to the next meeting so we could inquire of counsel what the limitations are
- The committee reviewed and prioritized the Brightview remediation plans for landscaping throughout the community
 - The priority list was forwarded to the Metro District board for adoption
- Meeting adjourned at 8:39p
