MINUTES

January 4, 2022 | 5:30 P.M via Zoom

Meeting was called to order at 5:31 p.m.

Design Status

Mr. Coldsnow presented the update to the committee. Site and civil plan submittals are under review with expected submission to city week of January 9, 2023. Committee discussed the photo used for area to be updated with current one. Mr. Besel discussed the narrative and the need for clarity to avoid confusion. After additional discussion the committee approved to recommend moving forward to the Board of Directors at the next meeting. Mr. Coldsnow requested a meeting with Ms. Grant to further discuss the process and gather further clarity on design.

Mr. Coldsnow relayed to the committee that the final design contract with the architect has been approved.

Mr. Scheirman informed the committee that the Geotechnical report is still pending. The field work has been completed and the report will be passed to committee members once received.

Mr. Heatherington presented the results of the community survey regarding use of the facility.

Public Comment

Ms. Osborne expressed how everyone in the community pays for these amenities and the Service Center should be shared equally by all members of the district, whether Hilltop or all-ages.

Mr. Haws asked about the occupancy for the uses of the facility. Committee will follow up with the engineering for that clarification.

Mr. Coldsnow, Mr. Besel and Mr. Forsman will plan on meeting with Ms. Grant to discuss further details on the occupancy limits and site plan submission. Mr. Scheirman will follow up for the Geotechnical report and pass to committee. Mr. Coldsnow will review the drainage letter for the submission for any pending questions. No additional input.
